3	(a) In General.—Section 8(c) of the Occupational
4	Safety and Health Act of 1970 (29 U.S.C. 657(e)) is
5	amended by adding at the end the following:
6	"(4) The Secretary may not issue an emergency
.7	temporary standard that requires an employer to en-
8	sure that employees of the employer have received a
9	COVID-19 vaccine or undergo COVID-19 testing.".
10	(b) APPLICATION.—The amendment under sub-
11	section (a) shall not apply to any emergency temporary
12	standard under section 8(c) of the Occupational Safety
13	and Health Act of 1970 (29 U.S.C. 657(c)) issued before
14	September 23, 2021. Any emergency temporary standard
15	described in paragraph (4) of such section issued after
16	such date shall have no force or effect.
