A BILL

To amend the Higher Education Act of 1965 to prohibit the imposition of COVID-19 vaccine mandates by institutions of higher education, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Ending COVID Vac-
- 5 cine Mandates for Colleges and Universities Act".

1 SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON COVID-19 VACCINE MANDATES.

- 2 Part B of title I of the Higher Education Act of 1965
- 3 (20 U.S.C. 1011 et seq.) is amended by adding at the end
- 4 the following:
- 5 "SEC. 124. PROHIBITION ON COVID-19 VACCINE MANDATES.
- 6 "(a) Prohibition.—An institution of higher edu-
- 7 cation that imposes a COVID-19 vaccine mandate shall
- 8 be ineligible to receive funds or otherwise participate in
- 9 programs under this Act for the duration of the period
- 10 during which such mandate is in effect.
- 11 "(b) COVID-19 VACCINE MANDATE DEFINED.—In
- 12 this section, the term 'COVID-19 vaccine mandate' means
- 13 any requirement that an individual receive an immuniza-
- 14 tion that is intended to prevent or mitigate COVID-19
- 15 as a condition of that individual's admission to, enrollment
- 16 in, or attendance or employment at an institution of high-
- 17 er education.".
