A BILL

To rescind certain balances made available to the Internal Revenue Service and redirect them to the U.S. Customs and Border Protection.

- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Diverting IRS Re-
- 5 sources to the Exigent Crisis Today Act" or the "DI-
- 6 RECT Act".

1 SEC. 2. RESCISSION OF CERTAIN BALANCES MADE AVAIL-

- 2 ABLE TO THE INTERNAL REVENUE SERVICE.
- 3 (a) In General.—The unobligated balances of
- 4 amounts appropriated or otherwise made available for en-
- 5 forcement activities of the Internal Revenue Service by
- 6 section 10301(1)(A)(ii) of Public Law 117–169 (com-
- 7 monly known as the "Inflation Reduction Act") as of the
- 8 date of the enactment of this Act are rescinded.
- 9 (b) Redirection of Funds to U.S. Customs and
- 10 BORDER PROTECTION.—There is appropriated to the U.S.
- 11 Customs and Border Protection for the salaries and ex-
- 12 penses of new agents and officers hired for the security
- 13 of the southern border of the United States an amount
- 14 equal to the amount rescinded pursuant to subsection (a).
